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Brief Description of Fund:

The Instructional, Research, and Clinical (IRC) Faculty Professional Development Fund supports professional development for (a) individual IRC faculty members and (b) groups of IRC faculty members. Individual faculty members may receive up to \$1000 in funding; no match is required. Half of this funding is reserved for lecturers; half for rostered IRC faculty. Administrators may apply for up to \$1000 to fund programming that will support a group of IRC faculty members within their program.

A total of \$20,000 was available through the IRC Faculty Professional Development Fund in Academic Year 2024. Funds were provided by the Office of the Provost.
